### **ABOUT THE PROGRAM**

The Mitigwa Lodge is offering you an opportunity to join together with other arrowmen in cheerful service and the formation of lasting brotherhood on the hills of beautiful Camp Mitigwa. Under the direction of Mitigwa Lodge youth members and two adult advisers with strong Order of the Arrow backgrounds, participants will be lead through the week trail crew.

The program is a 7-day experience. There will be on a project selected by the Mid-Iowa Council and the Mitigwa Lodge. Each week we will need twelve youth and two adults. The program is not necessarily trail work but the Trail Crew is ultimately a journey that will challenge scouts mentally, physically, and spiritually. Some Trail Crew members may be asked to serve as Elangomats leading clans working on the related project.

The experience is full of long, strenuous days requiring a great deal of physical effort. Participants are expected to work with great diligence. The project will last many years to come and benefit Camp Mitigwa and the surrounding areas. Trail Crew members will strengthen their leadership skills, observe and participate in group safety, good judgment, and motivation activities, and receive Order of Arrow instruction. The project mission is to maintain, reinforce and enhance the purpose of the Order of the Arrow by using scout camping traditions. Participants are expected to use their experience to benefit their scout unit, chapter, Lodge, and Council programs. Camping is a method of scouting that enhances and builds stronger programs and people.

### **REQUIREMENTS**

- As a youth be at least 14 years old during the year the program begins, but not 21 by the weeks conclusion.
- A \$20.00 fee will be charged upon acceptance to the program
- Be strong and robust.
- A current physical and health history form must be brought with you to camp.
- The week you apply for may NOT be your unit's week of camp.
- The participant must attend camp with the unit unless he serves as a staff member when the troop is in camp.
- Be a registered member of the BSA and the Mitigwa Lodge.

*Apply for any exceptions to these requirements. Selection for this program is voluntary and is both an honor and a privilege.*

### **HOW TO APPLY**

Complete the enclosed application and have it approved by your scouting unit leader, and receive (if you are under 18 years of age) parental permission. *Mail your completed application:* Mid-Iowa Council Service Center, P0 Box 3009, Des Moines, IA, 50316. The lodge will notify you of your acceptance.

## **MITIGWA TRAIL CREW CODE OF CONDUCT**

The general welfare of any group depends on the conduct of each individual member. This ensures the success of our lodge service project and provides the maximum benefit to every participant. As an Arrowman, I understand this and support the reasonable demands of conduct expected of me.

As a member of the Order of the Arrow I will:

Live the Scout Oath and Law and the Order of the Arrow Obligation

Observe, respect and strive to live the Boy Scout Outdoor Code.

Observe the rules of the Camp Mitigwa Scout Reservation and my Adult Advisers.

Wear my full official scout uniform or work clothes as required. Unofficial decorations are not part of my official uniform.

Attend and participate in all functions of the program.

Be personally responsible for loss or damage of personal property.

Respect all safety procedures and learn to properly use equipment.

Observe quiet hours.

Keep my sleeping area clean and dispose of trash in proper places.

At all times, be considerate of the participants and staff at Mitigwa Scout Reservation.

Understand the purchase, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages, cigarettes or illicit drugs at any time during the program will not be permitted and will result in dismissal from the program at the expense of the participant. This standard shall apply to all participants. Compliance with the state law regulations will apply at all times.

Respect the laws of the state of Iowa and the rules of the Mitigwa Scout Reservation prohibiting the use of fireworks, firearms and gambling. Infraction of these regulations will be grounds for immediate dismissal at the participant's expense.
